PHYSICAL SCIENCE:

Solids, Liquids, Gases and Characteristics of Earth ~ Students will discover the properties of Solids, liquids, and gasses and develop an understanding of how matter can undergo change by heating and cooling.

LIFE SCIENCE

Plants and Animals ~ Students will explore the physical structures that help plants and animals survive in their environments. We will learn about the cycle of development that all living things go through.

HUMAN BODY

Characteristics and Heredity ~ Students will investigate why living things have certain traits that are inherited from their 'parents'.

EARTH SCIENCE

Weather and Earth's Changes ~ Students will develop an understanding that the universe, Earth and all Earth systems have undergone change in the past, continue to change in the present and are predicted to continue changing in the future.
